As late as 1957, frankfurters were, for the most part, unadulterated—“the best meat” for consumers to buy. But by 1969, that found in the meat used to make them (about 70 percent). With the exception of a few, however, the demand for meat grew tremendously, and the use of filters (grains, dried milk, starch, soy flour) and increased the fat content of the meat. By 1970, the once straightforward wiener had departed markedly from its original form, containing 26 percent fat and well over 50 percent water. The dog that was formerly solid, and in spite of the outcry from consumer advocates, continued to grow. (Figure 1 shows the mutation of the dog.)






