Despite a lot of advance publicity, TV viewers are bound to be surprised when Channel 10 debuts its new affiliations late next month. So the two stations, aided by their prospectus, have mounted a full-blown public relations campaign to capture the coming.





Water, Water Everywhere, But is it Safe to Drink?

The Assistant Manager says he's been thinking of San Diego. "The only people who aren't afraid of their first drink of municipal water are the ones who live in New York or the East River, or maybe the Mississippi Delta. And those are the people who are getting their water by hand as salt." After a short time your taste buds will begin to complain. You have to wash down the ring off the glass, and your face cracks when you smile.


The Colorado River, source for the Colorado River Delta, which flows through Colorado and Utah, then forms a natural border between the two states, is the water neighbor before disappearance into the Colorado. It picks up more than two dozen dissolved minerals, some of which are beneficial, others are not. Minerals are nutrients; others like nitrates, sulfates, and lead are toxic. Unwary consumers can be misled with millions of people having no idea what they are getting at the tap, and if they do, they don't know how to get rid of it.

"There's no way to tell what kind of water you're getting from a well," says Bob Carlson, owner of a new distributor, Bob's Bottled Water, located in the San Diego area. "It's not unusual for people drinking water—at least 40% were getting 'unpleasant' tasting water."

Not surprisingly, San Diego houses a large and flourishing industry of water systems, ranging from bottled drinking water, which may cost a few dollars a gallon, to reverse osmosis systems which can cost \$1,000, installed.

The "water" industry that corporate America has created, California Beverage Company, Inc., for example, is one of the most successful and largest in the country, serving San Diego, Sparklets, a subsidiary of Fontana-Citrus, and the rest of California. And, after, when half the \$20 million market is taken by the rest of California, partly due to the poor quality—though it is not the only reason—of San Diego's water.

There is considerable controversy among scientists about the "health" of water. One view claims that hard water is better for you, while another claims that soft water is better because studies have shown that people in soft-water areas are






