








## For A Few Pesos More

Mexican Auto Insurance Is Worth It

Describing the interior of a Mexican jail is one of the more clichéd forms of tourism boasting in San Diego. Everyone seems to have done some jail time, or to have a friend who has landed themselves in trouble. I was invited to the Long Bar in Tijuana to sit at a night of unspeakable degradation in the local jail.

Lots of lies. Very few Americans see the inside of a Mexican jail and those who do, do not stay long. They are either too drunk, or too dumbfounded, followed by those who have found themselves in a Mexican jail, to last the night. In fact, a serious accident happened to be the only way to visit the police station. A charge of barroom drunkenness.

After all, involves some discretion on the part of the policeman, whereas a traffic accident is a clear-cut case of guilt or innocence. If someone is killed or injured, the law requires the drivers deemed responsible for the accident, to be detained until those persons to blame are identified. No U.S. policy has the power in a Mexican court. Once identified, the driver can be released, which may be done within an hour after the accident, or it will allow the accident to stand. The exception occurs when someone has committed a grievous error.

Do not be afraid pitch for Mexican insurance—as we will see, it

often incomplete coverage provided by most U.S. policies—but in Mexico it is literally the only kind of insurance to have, and is often the only kind you need. If someone is killed or injured, the law requires the drivers deemed responsible for the accident, to be detained until those persons to blame are identified. No U.S. policy has the power in a Mexican court. Once identified, the driver can be released, which may be done within an hour after the accident, or it will allow the accident to stand. The exception occurs when someone has committed a grievous error.

resulting in a victim's death or permanent disability. Here in the United States, the law permits the full damages to be assessed, which may take days. Mexican law permits the assessment to be made in a place where the person to blame is drunk or under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

But minor accidents, resulting only in fenders and egos, routinely get settled on the spot at the scene of the accident. Most reports do not believe the negotiator who says he spent three days in a Mexican jail is telling the truth. However, vehicles involved in the accident may be impounded for up to 24 hours. The damage, or lack thereof, is all up to the insurance company. Here again Mexican insurance

can guarantee the payment of damages which permits the release of a car.

One of the best things to be said for Mexican insurance is that it is inexpensive. For example, a minimum one-day coverage of \$40 for \$3,000 can be compared to \$10 for a minimum one-day coverage of \$10,000 in the United States. Because all Mexican insurance companies are governmentally controlled, they are not where in Mexico or on this side of the border. Therefore, it pays to shop for service, but not necessarily price.

The Mexican police, has its fine points, of course. It offers no protection, but if your car is broken into and looted, the camera, wallet, clothing, and other personal items are insured. Neither does the insurance cover vehicles not named in the policy.

Without suggesting that any tourist has an accident in Mexico, it would be instructive to view a model accident which demonstrates the difference between Mexican and American insurance.
