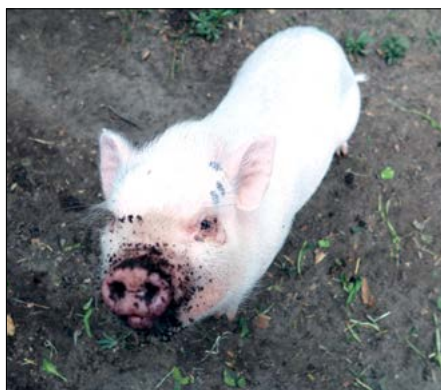

LINGER AT THE LAGOON

After your North County excursion has taken you to Legoland, the Flower Fields, Oceanside Harbor, and the San Diego Botanic Garden, you may start wondering what else there is for you to do. Here's something: check out the Discovery Center on Cannon Road, and once you're there, maybe wonder why you've never been there before. Yes, it's that kind of place.

"When I started here 14 years ago, my goal was to make this a place where people would stay for at least 45 minutes," says Lisa Rodman, the center's CEO. "Now, nobody stays for just 45 minutes — we've had people stay for half a day or even longer." With good reason. What opened in 2006 as the teaching hub for the Agua Hedionda Lagoon Foundation (the nonprofit charged with ensuring the lagoon's health) is now popular destination that last year attracted more than 55,000 visitors, most of them young families with kids.

Located on Cannon Road, about a mile east of the I-5 freeway, on the southern shores of the lagoon, the Discovery Center features an exhibit room holding Native American and Spanish Rancho artifacts, a fish tank where kids can interact with fish, sea stars, sea cucumbers, and other sea creatures; a picnic area with panoramic views of the lagoon and Pacific Ocean; 3.6 miles of hiking trails through coastal sage and chaparral; and critters, many of them rescues, including raptors, lizards, snakes, geckos, tortoises, and a bearded drag-

on. Oh, and a white pot-bellied pig named Bingo. "She is definitely a star at the lagoon," Rodman says, "and she cohabits with a flock of chickens and her friend, Tortie, a desert tortoise." Bingo is friendly, especial-

on learning about everything from lagoon history to migratory birds, watersheds, and Native American culture. More than 70,000 kids have attended. There's a summer camp for kids between the ages of five and ten,

ly when visitors purchase Bingo Bags filled with her favorite food. The center is also home to Fairyland, underneath a towering native oak, where kids can adopt fairies and even write letters to them. The fairies promptly write back, Rodman promises — in English or in Spanish.

And while piggies and fairies are fun, education remains a top priority. The center continues to pride itself on its Academy for Environmental Stewardship, a field-trip program for third graders that incorporates hands-

a preschool for toddlers between the ages of three and five, and a Brick Walkway campaign that awards scholarships to kids from underserved areas for a week-long STEAM education program that culminates with the kids participating in a Habitat for Humanities house build. "Last year we had 55 kids participate," Rodman says, "and this year, we're shooting for 75."

Admission is a suggested donation of \$15, and that gives guests the run of the place, for as long as they want.

BEER AND BIG BOSS BATTLES

BattleMage

There is an abundance of breweries throughout San Diego County, and many of them offer excellent beers. And while 20 years ago, we were all fine with simply pulling up a stool in a warehouse-turned-brewery and sipping on beers we couldn't find elsewhere, now we're flush with options. Today, breweries and tasting rooms need to offer something more than just quality suds. Maybe it doesn't have to be somewhere "where everybody knows your name and they're always glad you came," but it does need to offer a sense of community in addition to great beer. And no brewery seems to understand that better than BattleMage.

BattleMage co-founders Ryan Sather and Chris Barry grew up playing — and bonding over — geeky games like *Everquest*, *World of Warcraft*, *Warhammer*, and *Magic: The Gathering*. So when it was time to open their brewery, the decision to build the brand around the gaming communities in which they were already entrenched was an easy and obvious one. Today, the Vista brewery is loaded with board games and arcade games for people of all ages and gaming experience, but the experience goes even further for the dedicated gamers.

On Mondays and Tuesdays at 6 pm, the brewery hosts expansive *Dungeons & Dragons* nights which fans of the RPG can join via Discord (<https://discord.gg/nzYkgxkzXU>). Founding Dungeon Master Jeremy Hinkey explains the grandiosity of these gatherings, "We set ourselves apart from other *D&D* events by having about ten games a week that are

all taking place in the same world at the same time. Everyone gets to influence the larger story. When there is a big boss to fight at the end of an arc, we have sixty players over the course of two nights all fighting that big boss together. We had to get creative and invent some new me-

tleMage's amber ale, Summon Ifrit won back-to-back medals at the World Beer Cup (gold in 2023 and silver in 2024). Those of us who lean toward the latter category may be interested in an annual membership to the BattleMager Guild, which offers 22-ounce mug pours for the price of

chanics to accommodate that." The *D&D* night's success (now on its fifth campaign) has extended beyond the brewery: the Dungeon Masters have created a podcast, *Loremasters*, which shows up on Instagram and TikTok and has a viral video with more than 500,000 views.

Sather describes the brewery as "a space where shared passions have turned into long-term connections. For some, that passion is *D&D*, trivia (the first Wednesday of every month), or *Magic: The Gathering* (the third Wednesday of every month). For others, it's simply the beer — Bat-

16 ounces, early access to beers, limited edition merch, and attendance at the annual Guild party.

Tim Ames, a BattleMage regular, expresses the brewery's impact on his life: "It's difficult to articulate how warm, connected, and supportive the community at BattleMage is. On a personal level, I met my wife, found my dream job, and made many of my closest friends there." The sense of belonging and community at BattleMage flows just as freely as its award-winning beers, and that's something that's not always easy to find.

LAYERED LOVE AFFAIR

Parlor Doughnuts

Everyone has their favorite donut shop. Donut Bar in Pacific Beach gets high marks, as does The Goods in Carlsbad, whose website promises “artisan doughnuts crafted with the finest locally sourced ingredients.” VG Donuts in Cardiff, which describes itself as “an old-fashioned bakery,” is something of a local institution, and was even mentioned in the mayor’s annual state of the city address a few years back. And then there are those who swear by chain standbys Dunkin’ Donuts and Krispy Kreme, the latter a favorite of my wife, who says the signature glazed donuts, especially when freshly made, remind her of her growing-up days in Alabama.

But if we’re being serious, we’re going to have to throw all of this out the door and crown the *real* best donut shop – not just in North County, not just in San Diego County, but, for my money (and tastebuds), the whole damn state, country, planet, universe, galaxy – you get the picture. I’m talking about Parlor Doughnuts in Oceanside, just past the underpass that leads to the coastal city’s famous (and recently burned) wooden pier. The donuts here are of a unique kind, made with layers of buttery dough and fried, leaving them crisp on the outside and light and fluffy on the inside. That means they’re about twice as big as standard donuts — and easily twenty times as tasty, particularly the French

Toast donut, which ranks right up there among my Favorite Foods of All Time (along with the cheese enchiladas at the now-defunct Nati’s in Ocean Beach, the squid sandwich on sourdough at Point Loma Seafoods, the tamales at Las Quatro Milpas in Barrio Logan, the *quesabirria* tacos at Señor Grub-

ar is just so delightful, particularly after a long walk along the Oceanside Strand and what’s left of the pier.

A little background, courtesy of the Parlor Donuts – er, Doughnuts – website: yes, it’s part of a chain, founded by a gentleman named Darrick Hayden, in partnership with Josh Tudela, in

by’s and Los Tacos in the Carlsbad/Oceanside area, and the prime rib at Boa in Hollywood. You might want to write those down.)

Other Parlor favorites include maple bacon, churro, peanut butter cup, turtle cheesecake, coconut cream-filled, maple pecan, lemonade, strawberry shortcake, and raspberry pistachio. I’ve tried several, and they are all outstanding, but I keep coming back to the French Toast because that judicious blend of maple cream and sug-

February 2019. Hayden’s son, Noah, used to be in a touring band, and while carrying out his roadie duties, Dad would visit local coffee shops and donut shops. That’s how he got the idea of using layered dough, as opposed to the traditional cake or yeast style.

The big, puffy donuts at Parlor will set you back just under \$4 apiece. In addition to layered donuts, Parlor offers keto-friendly doughnuts and an assortment of specialty coffees.

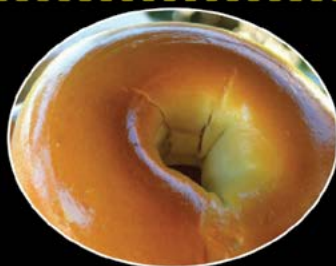

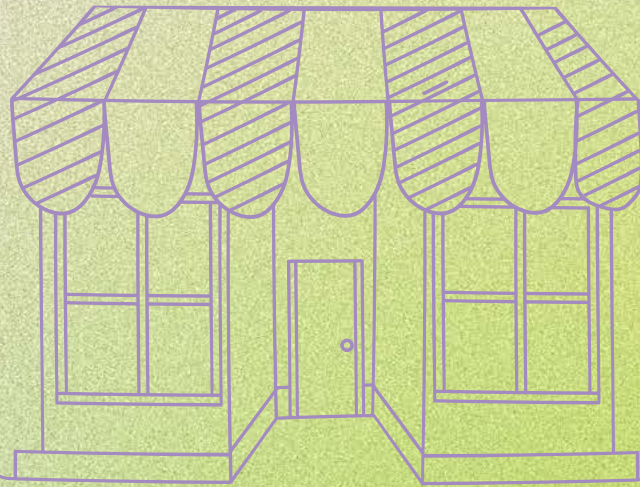

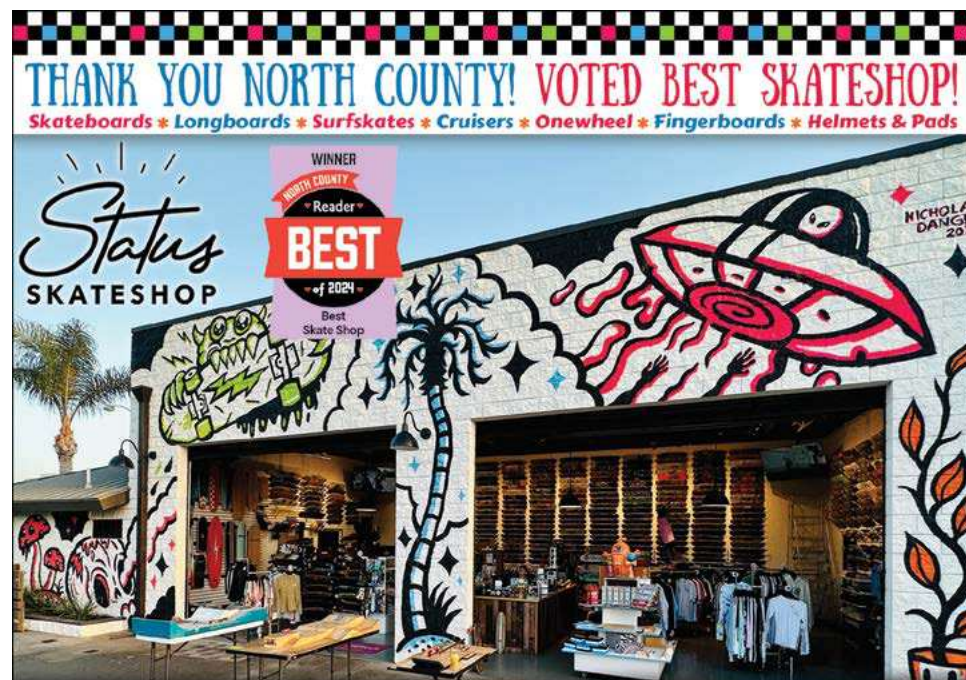

Lake Calavera Preserve

Who needs a gym, or even a treadmill, when you've got ... this?

Tucked between Carlsbad and Oceanside, Lake Calavera Preserve is a natural fitness center, with miles upon miles of hiking trails, a picturesque lake, and a volcanic plug that's a great place for a leg workout — a half-mile climb that's nearly straight up. The topography is remarkably varied. There's a nearly two-mile hike around the lake, which is home to egrets, herons, ducks, and coots. Portions of the trail are shaded by trees. Further east, there are hilly red-sand trails straight out of Sedona. And on the

northeast corner is the Oak Riparian Trail, a stunning walk along a little river that makes you think you're somewhere in the backcountry, like Cuyamaca. Two huge granite outcrops, jutting out from beneath towering oak trees, are ideal spots for family or group photos.

Lake Calavera Preserve covers about 260 acres and is the largest contiguous natural area in coastal North County. This large plot of open space is bordered on the north, west and east by

residential developments, while to the south lies an even bigger natural area, the Carlsbad Highland Ecological Reserve, which is owned by the state and administered by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The preserve is part of Carlsbad's

Habitat Management Plan — a regional conservation plan used to comply with federal and state laws to protect threatened and endangered species. It's the largest of 13 city-owned nature preserves in Carlsbad and home to four sensitive plant species and 12 sensitive animal species. In addition, there are 17 native vegetation communities on site, including Diegan coastal sage scrub, southern mixed chaparral, southern willow scrub, mulefat scrub and fresh-

water marsh.

Now, about that volcanic plug. What locals call Mount Calavera is what's left of an ancient volcano that erupted sometime between 13 million and 18 million years ago. A cut in the volcano dates back to when rock was mined

to construct Calavera Lake Dam during the World War II years, turning the lake into a reservoir. Mira Costa College students often venture to the volcano on field trips; according to a college website, "the magma that created the volcano forced its way to the surface along a fault where it erupted, creating a cinder cone, with lava flows. The surface the volcano

formed on was a coastal plain blanketed with flat-lying sedimentary rock that was originally deposited in or along the shores of a shallow marine embayment that extended inland to the base of the mountain ranges to the east."

Hiking to the top of the plug affords visitors panoramic views all the way to the Pacific Ocean. There are three labyrinths, the origins of which are unknown.

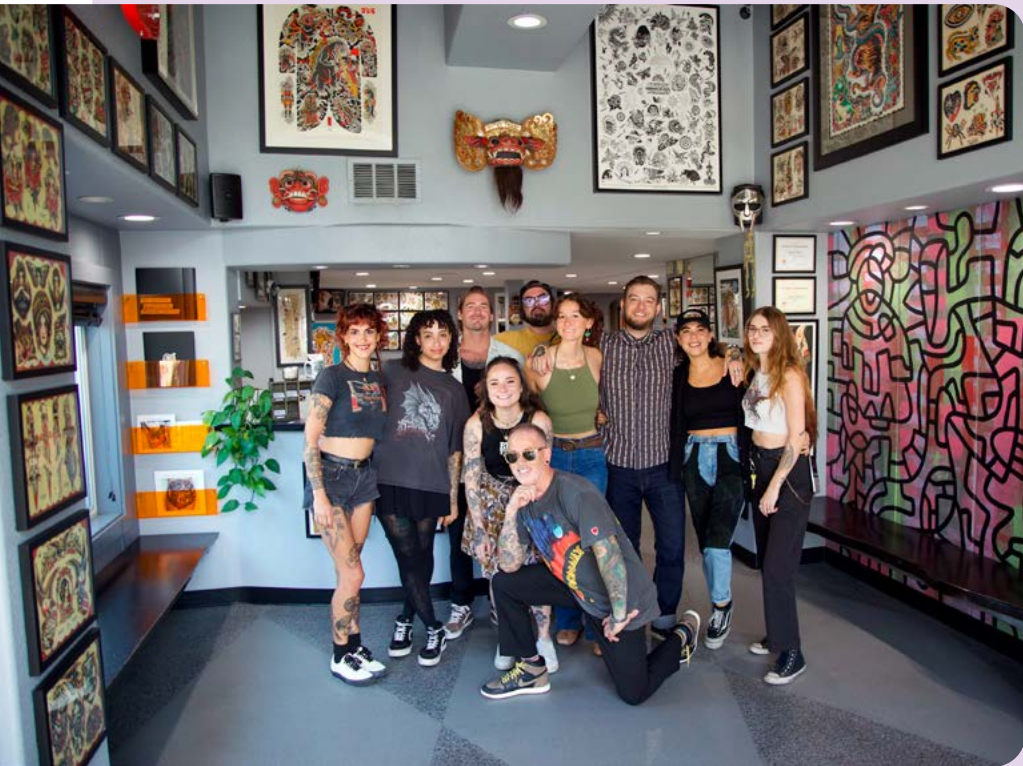

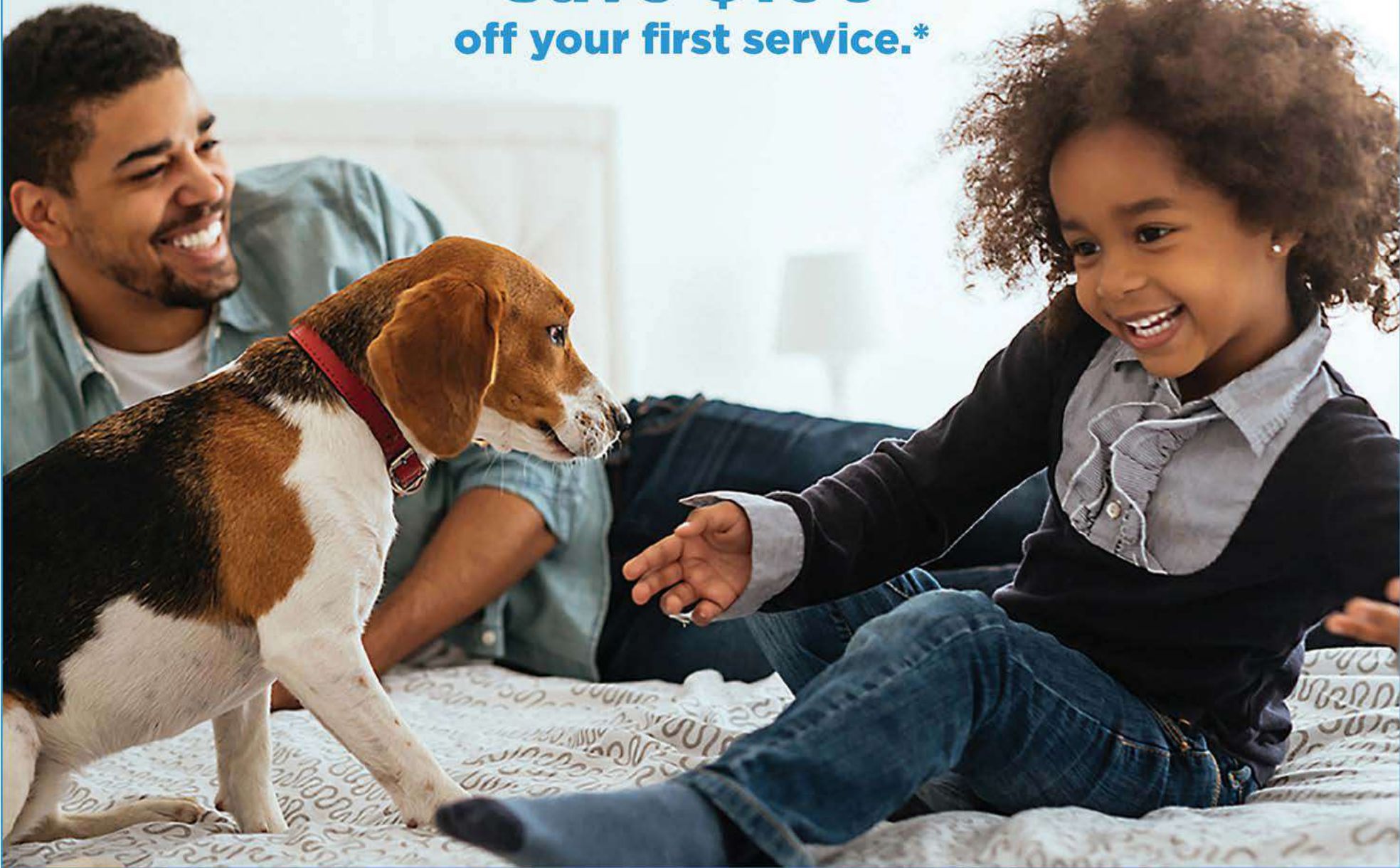

It's an impressive accessory. But after a certain age, no matter what he drives, a man never looks as good as he does when wearing a properly tailored suit. (Probably before that age as well, but I'm not here to argue.) He can get close with something made-to-measure: a suit based on a template, which is then cut and trimmed according to 15 or so measurements. Or he can make *himself* the template, and go bespoke. For that, he would do well to visit John Park's Zeglio Custom Clothiers on La Jolla Boulevard. (There's another

He stands me before a mirror and holds up his tape. "Your right shoulder is lower than your left," he observes. It turns out my right arm is longer as well. He doesn't need to tell me that I slouch, but he does need to take it into account. The

belly, on the other hand, will help determine the placement of the jacket's top button. "If we go lower, it looks more slim." 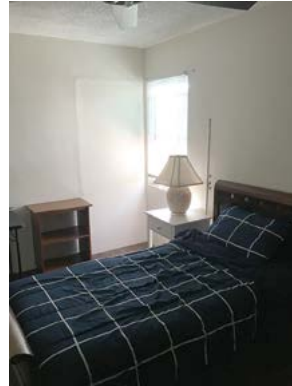

A cool year in a warming Pacific – Pelagic species have comfort zones

Dock Totals 10/6 – 10/12: 2928 anglers aboard 143 half-day to 3-day trips out of San Diego landings over the past week caught 1687 bluefin tuna (up to 195 pounds), 47 bocaccio, 35 bonito, 8 calico bass, 5 halibut, 65 lingcod, 48 rock crab, 6786 rockfish, 3 rock sole, 39 sand bass, 14 sanddab, 481 sculpin, 123 sheephead, 152 spiny lobster (259 released), 893 whitefish, 1 white seabass, 17 yellowfin tuna, and 740 yellowtail.

Saltwater: The bluefin tuna catch highlights what was another solid week for the San Diego fleet during what has been an odd fishing season off the west coast. While Atlantic hurricanes have been thumping the Gulf Coast and southeastern states, the hurricane season off Baja has been pretty much a no-show to this point. Generally, those storms form off the Mexican mainland far to the south, then make their way north and west, sometimes skirting Cabo before heading out toward Hawaii, but sometimes hooking north along or across Baja.

The storms that push more north than west bring warmer water with them. Without any storms pushing water up into the northern stretches along the Baja coast, the pelagic species we often see tend to show little within three-day range of Point Loma. The last two seasons featured those warm-water pushing storms, and we saw record numbers of dorado and a solid yellowfin bite. (In addition: the warmer the water along southern Baja's Pacific coast, the stronger the odds of a storm moving up rather than west, and with it, still more warm water.) This year has been fairly cool along the coast, with water temps averaging between 64 and 66 degrees at most of the offshore spots where we usually see more yellowfin and dorado in late summer and fall.

Pelagic species, those that live in open ocean in the upper part of the water column, tend to follow their desired temperature range during annual migrations. That and the baitfish upon which they feed. Baitfish are sensitive to temperature breaks where warm and cooler currents collide, and a drop as small as a couple degrees can act as a wall, stacking them along the warm side of the difference. This is why knowing water temperatures can be advantageous to the angler.

NOAA's National Data Buoy Center has positioned buoys off our coast north of the border, and you can check the conditions at each buoy before heading out. TerraFin, TempBreak, and FishTrack are three subscriber websites where anglers can get more accurate information for the fishing areas along Baja and southern California. (They do offer some basic charts without subscribing.)

During this cooler year, a few albacore were caught, but again, it was just a tease. Albacore shifted their migration pattern seemingly permanently a couple decades ago and are now mostly caught within 50 miles of the coast centering on the area near Westport on the Washington/Oregon border. This is due to the warming trend in our area pushing the average Sea Surface Temperatures (SSTs) in the summer well above the 60- to 66-degree range they favor.

Some species are more adapted to a wider range in SSTs, notably, bluefin tuna with their

endothermic system that basically makes them warm-blooded. Bluefin migrate over to the eastern Pacific from off Japan through some very chilly water in a northern arc, then settle in off our coast for a few years until they reach spawning age, whereupon they return to the western Pacific. This year and its cooler SSTs have had little effect on them, and this is why we are still seeing good numbers. We even had a little flurry of striped marlin action within a day's ride of Point Loma, but stripers, too, can handle a wider range of temps, from 67 degrees to 77 degrees.

Yellowfin tuna and dorado have been absent for the most part, with very few yellowfin caught and practically no dorado at all within three-day range for the fleet. Yellowfin prefer 64 to 88 degrees, and mostly to the high side of that; we see more of them when the water is in the 68 degrees and up into the 70s for extended periods. Dorado like bathwater temps and will be more prevalent if there is very warm water: from the mid-70s up into the 80s. Yellowtail, however, start biting well in 64-degree water and will still be around in the low 70s, so, even though their numbers have been lower than

average, there has been some solid action on good-sized yellowtail — but no swarms of the small 5 to 10-pounders we often see during warmer years. Outside of the phenomenal bluefin fishing, another bonus from the cooler trends this year has been a decent white seabass and halibut bite. White seabass can handle a broad range, from 46 to 75 degrees, but spend most of their time within the narrow temperature gap between 55 and 61 degrees. They are often found in the mid-water column near structure and kelp beds, while California halibut prefer water around 60 to 65 degrees, down in the lower part of the water column.

Given the offshore and nearshore SSTs, we can see why the counts this year favor bluefin, yellowtail, white seabass, and halibut and an overall lack of yellowfin and dorado. South of Cedros Island is a different story. Where the coastal kelps along the Vizcaino Peninsula midway down Baja give way to warmer semi-tropical biospheres, there has been some excellent yellowfin action, and south of that, along the ridges off Bahia Magdalena, wahoo fishing has been off the hook for the long-range fleet working the area. Trip lengths of at least five to eight days are recommended if you're after those warmer-water species this season. But bluefin and yellowtail have still been biting well as close as the Coronado Islands for full-day boats, and 1.5 to 3-day boats have been finding larger bluefin way out west past San Clemente Island at the Cherry Bank this past week. Whether the beach, bay, lake, or offshore, they're out there so go out and get 'em!

What's My Fetish?

— Jesse Johnson, 28, was arrested on Sept. 24 in Gilbert, Arizona, after three instances in which he allegedly spied on women's feet as they vacuumed their cars, *AZFamily* reported. Police said Johnson's M.O. at the Super Star Car Wash in Gilbert was to park next to a woman's car at the vacuum station, then slide underneath her car for a few minutes before climbing back out. One victim said she felt "very violated and I've been having nightmares." It's not the first time Johnson has been caught lusting after feet: court documents revealed that he had been cited at least four times in Nebraska, and that he had touched a woman's ankle in a grocery store. He admitted to authorities there that he "is sexually attracted to women's feet" and "at times, can't control his sexual desires." Johnson was charged with three counts of voyeurism and three counts of disorderly conduct and held on \$10,000 bond.

News You Can Use

— When Hannah Willow arrived at the Scottish Tree Hugging Championships in Glasgow on Oct. 6, she thought the event was a charity affair, *The Guardian* reported on Oct. 9. "When I was told it was a competition, my inner child took a somersault ... This was a moment of glory for me," Willow said. Now, she's on her way to the World Tree Hugging Championship in HaliPuu Forest in Finland in August 2025. She's already strategizing about how to win: "I need to step up my game for the world championships," she said. "I will have to bring out my fairy wings and my

ukelele and go singing to the trees." Willow said her children were "hugely embarrassed" to learn she had won the Glasgow contest.

— As if folks in Florida didn't have enough to worry about, State Fire Marshal Jimmy Patronis announced on Oct. 9 that after Hurricane Helene came through in September, at least 48 fires involving lithium-ion batteries had been reported -- 11 in electric vehicles. "Floridians living on the coastline who own EVs are at risk of those EVs being inundated with saltwater storm surge, which presents a dangerous fire threat to Florida families and homes," Patronis said, according to WFTS-TV. Other products like electric scooters, golf carts or children's toys also could be affected. "These compromised vehicles and devices are ticking time bombs," Patronis said. He suggested people move affected vehicles away from their homes.

Great Art?

— A work of art at the LAM museum in Lisse, the Netherlands, was mistakenly thrown away by an elevator technician in late September, CNN reported. "All the good times we spent together" by French artist Alexandre Lavet appears to be two empty beer cans, but, the museum said, it is really "meticulously hand-painted with acrylics, with each detail painstakingly replicated." The work was displayed in the facility's glass elevator shaft, and when a technician came in to work on the lift, he helpfully pitched it in the trash. "He was just doing his job in good faith," said Sietske van Zanten, the museum director. The cans were later recovered,

cleaned and returned to display, albeit in a different location.

Awesome!

— Reddit user Springchikun was doing some lawn cleanup in September when she noticed that a small hatch leading to a crawlspace under her home was unlatched. *The New York Post* reported that the Oregon woman investigated, finding a makeshift bed and several bags of belongings. She noted that the crawlspace was free of cobwebs, suggesting that someone had been there recently. "I'm sure someone is using the space," she said. But Springchikun didn't want to call the authorities about the squatter. "We have an option to be kind," she said. Instead, she wrote the person a note, offering support such as food, a phone or help with resources. As a result, she met her unexpected guest, whose name is Gaby, and connected her with a friend who could help her with shelter and a mental health evaluation. "I'm not without empathy," she said. "I just can't have humans living under my home."

Family Values

— Indonesian police have arrested a man near Jakarta, identified as RA, after he allegedly sold his 11-month-old baby on Facebook for \$995 to fund his gambling addiction. *The Telegraph* reported that when the baby's mother returned home, she asked him where the child was. "RA saw on Facebook that the buyers were looking to purchase a toddler so he sent them a message and arranged the purchase," the police chief said. Police found the child in a rented home and arrested two

adults suspected of human trafficking.

— Tizi Hodson, 70, of Lincolnshire, England, sent off an application in January 1976, hoping to become a motorcycle stunt rider, the BBC reported on Oct. 5. Recently, the letter was returned to her with a note: "Late delivery by Staines Post Office. Found behind a draw(er). Only about 50 years late." "How they found me when I've moved house 50-odd times, and even moved countries four or five times, is a mystery," Hodson said. "I was so disappointed because I really, really wanted to be a stunt rider on a motorcycle." Instead, her life's work has included being a snake handler, horse whisperer, aerobatic pilot and flying instructor. "It means so much to me to get it back all this time later," she said.

Saw That Coming

— On Oct. 6, 36-year-old Clejuan Williams of Toledo, Ohio, was teaching his 9-year-old son how to back up the car (first mistake) with another child in the backseat (second mistake). Williams was standing outside the car with the driver's door open, WTVG reported, and told the boy to hit the brake. When the child pressed the wrong pedal, Williams, who was intoxicated (third mistake), was struck and dragged under the car. He was taken to the hospital and is expected to face charges of wrongful entrustment of a motor vehicle and endangering children.

Jessica McElfresh

“Legalize it, don’t criticize it,” went the old Peter Tosh song. It sounds so simple — until you remember that “legalize” means bringing in the law, and the law is never simple. For the law, you need a lawyer.

Attorney Jessica McElfresh got into cannabis law “kind of by accident.” She wanted to be a prosecutor, but graduated law school just after the 2008 economic crash, when what you wanted didn’t necessarily matter. “I wound up helping a criminal defense attorney in LA and San Diego with some medical marijuana cases, and he suggested that there was more work there than I realized. And there was this strange moment in 2010 when we thought an appellate court was going to rule that cities had to allow storefront collectives in some form. My mother had been a land use consultant in Southern California, and so I had some background in how conditional use permits and things like that worked, what they were used for and why. After that, I never really left. I hunkered down during the 2011 Federal crackdown, represented some of the original 15 licensed storefronts in the city, and started consulting on some ballot initiatives.”

Today, the bulk of McElfresh’s time is spent helping prospective businesses survive the unmellow world of regulatory compliance. In an attempt to sidestep the world of filthy lucre, I asked a section on her website related to growing, but she says that’s not as much of an issue any more. “We don’t get nearly as many phone calls from people who have been raided for cultivating in the home,” partly be-

cause the cops are doing fewer raids, and partly because homeowners are growing fewer plants, “trying to navigate a very complicated and unclear set of laws about how much you can grow and what you can do with it.” Back to business it is, then.

But “complicated” and “unclear”

ceed a certain concentration. And yet, Governor Newsom just issued an emergency regulation banning hemp products with any detectable quantity of THC. (He argued for the protection of children; McElfresh notes that cheap hemp intoxicants were also eroding the tax base.) “Technically,

are not words applicable only to growing. “We’re still trying to figure out what regulation should look like,” says McElfresh, “stumbling around in the dark about things like not overtaxing at both the state and local level.” We’re even fuzzy on the precise nature of the “it” in “legalize it.” She brings up the issue of intoxicating, ingestible hemp products. Google will tell you that “according to the 2018 Farm Bill, Delta 9 THC products derived from industrial hemp are considered legal at the Federal level” as long as they do not ex-

there’s always a small amount,” says McElfresh. But more than that, “I’m really amused to hear some people say that Federal law is supreme when it comes to hemp products” — especially given the Federal opposition to legalized marijuana.

“The fight right now is what states can and cannot do to additionally regulate” in light of the Farm Bill. “And it’s really all over the place. It’s an area of law that people have been treating as crystal clear, but it’s actually really complicated.” Bring on the lawyers!

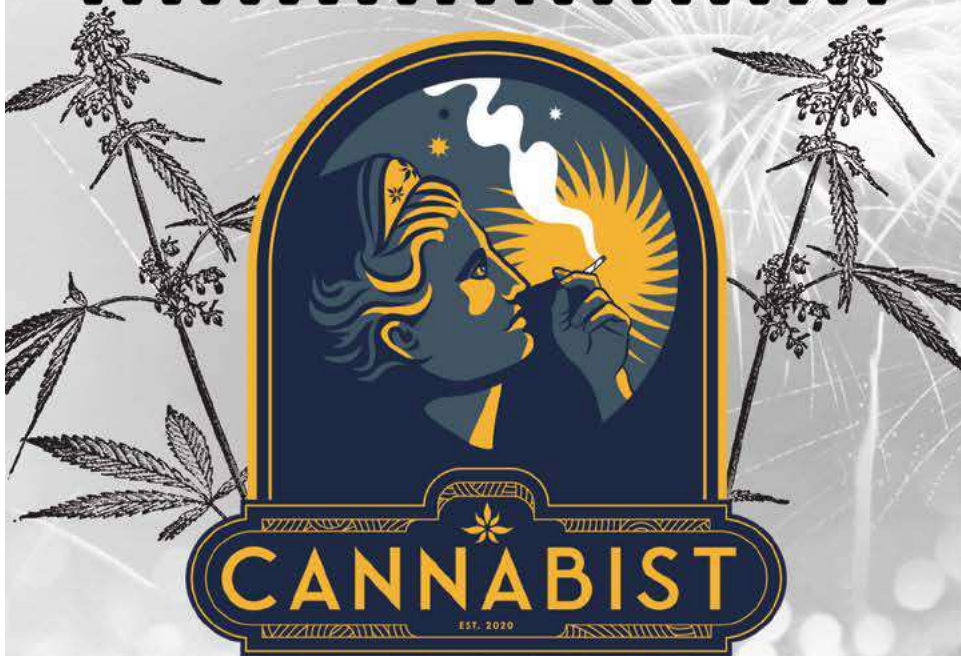

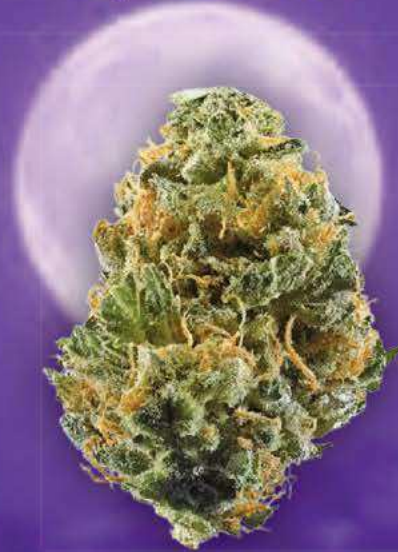
